The Menzies Research institute (Menzies) and the University Department of Rural Health (UDRH) are offering three (3) Primary Health Care Research, Evaluation and Development (PHCRED) conference attendance travel grants in 2010.

In the first round, there are two \$1,500 grants available, one from Menzies and one from UDRH.

These grants are designed to allow a research-active primary health care practitioner to attend a national conference in 2010 to advance their research activities. In awarding these grants, preference will be given to presenters, especially if peer reviewed. Applications will also be considered to use the travel funds to allow a national or international PHC researcher to visit the state to conduct research capacity building activities.

In the second half of 2010, Menzies will offer one additional grant of \$1,500. Again this grant is designed to allow a research-active primary health care practitioner to attend a national conference in 2010 to advance their research activities. Applications for Round 2 will be called in June 2010.

First round applications close 5pm Friday 19<sup>th</sup> February 2010.
